Path needed from Burnbank crossroads to Foulden Village	40	Land donated, grant applied for, grant confirmed (from Fallago Environment Fund) and work has started.
Paths need more regular maintenance	40	Grant applied for, self-propelled wheeled trimmer ordered. We have a new Footpaths maintenance man / mowing operator poised to start in the spring
Litter	35	Pick sticks obtained (from Sea the Change), volunteers requested, August and September picks organised on A6105. Volunteers continuing over the winter.
Tennis courts	15	Grant applied for to refurbish the courts and include a multi-use games area.
Potholes	55	Link with details on how to inform Scottish Borders Council now on the FMLCC website and social media. Temporary repairs made on some roads.
Speed	50	Points made in submission to SBC. Included in Scottish Borders 30mph to 20mph initiative. Also 40mph to 30mph in Foulden.
